Friday, September 4: Paris-Eiffel Tower Tickets

This afternoon, make your way to the Eiffel tour-19 Av. de la Bourdonnais, (walking directions included or take a short taxi ride). Your time slot is scheduled for 3:30 pm (please arrive 45 minutes you will need to wait the security line even if you have tickets for a tickets- there is a separate line for ticket holders.



The Eiffel Tower is one of the most famous landmarks in Paris, France. It was designed by engineers Maurice Koechlin and Émile Nouguier, with architect Stephen Sauvestre, and was built by the company of engineer Gustave Eiffel. Construction began in 1887 and was completed in just over two years, in time for the 1889 World's Fair, which celebrated the 100th anniversary of the French Revolution. When it opened, the Eiffel Tower was the tallest structure in the world. Although some people criticized its unusual iron design at first, it quickly became a huge success and attracted nearly two million visitors during the World's Fair.

Take the lift up the Eiffel Tower and enjoy amazing views of Paris from different levels. From the second floor, you can see famous landmarks such as the Seine River, the Louvre, Notre-Dame, Montmartre, and Les Invalides. If you take the lift to the summit, about 276 metres above the ground, you can see an even wider panoramic view of the city. From so high up, Paris looks like a beautiful map, with its streets, buildings, parks, and river stretching into the distance. The Eiffel Tower's lifts were themselves an impressive achievement when they were introduced in 1889, helping visitors reach the upper levels safely

The Eiffel Tower has become an important symbol of Paris and France and remains one of the most visited monuments in the world. Beyond being a tourist attraction, it has also been used for scientific experiments and communications throughout its history. Gustave Eiffel even had an office at the top of the tower, where he welcomed guests and supported scientific work.
