Thursday, September 3: New York-Paris

2:40 pm (approx.) – Arrival at Newark Airport (approx. 3 hours prior to departure)

Proceed to the United Airlines Check-in Desk assigned to your flight and present your passports.

Upon receipt of your Boarding Passes & Luggage Tags, proceed through Security to your assigned gate and await the boarding of your flight

This evening, depart on United Airlines flight #57 scheduled to depart at 5:40 pm and arrives the following morning at Paris, CDG Airport at 7:05 am.

Thursday, September 3: Newark-Paris (Larissa & Stefen Peleschuk)

25:00 pm (approx.) – Arrival at Newark Airport (approx. 3 hours prior to departure)

Proceed to the Airlines Check-in Desk assigned to your flight and present your passports.

Upon receipt of your Boarding Passes & Luggage Tags, proceed through Security to your assigned gate and await the boarding of your flight

This evening, depart on La Compagnie flight # 101 scheduled to depart at 7:00 pm and arrives the following morning at Paris, Orly Airport at 8:40 am.

Thursday, September 3: New York-Paris (Yaroslawa & Myron Perich)

5:30 pm (approx.) – Arrival at Terminal '4', JFK Int'l Airport (approx. 3 hours prior to departure)

Proceed to the Delta Airlines Check-in Desk assigned to your flight and present your passports.

Upon receipt of your Boarding Passes & Luggage Tags, proceed through Security to your assigned gate and await the boarding of your flight

This evening, depart on Delta Airlines flight # 266 scheduled at 8:15 pm and arrive the following morning at Paris, CDG Airport at 10:00 am.

Friday, September 4: Paris-Hotel Plaza Elysees

Today, upon arrival in Paris, claim your luggage, and continue to the arrivals hall.

Your Driver will be holding a sign with your group name (Dunwoodie)

Please Note: *If you're delayed, be sure to call the telephone numbers on the voucher.*

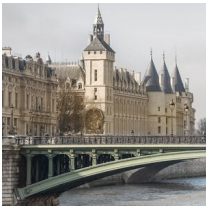
Please have the cell phone turned on as the driver may try to reach you

Enjoy your approx. 45-minute private transfer to Hotel Plaza Elysees, your home, for the nights

Please Note: *Check in is usually 2:00 pm, however the hotel will try to accommodate you earlier if the room is available. If your room isn't ready, they will gladly hold your luggage. Perhaps you'll enjoy a nice café au lait in a local café while you wait..*

Paris was constructed 2,000 thousand years ago and divided in 20 districts, each one a village with its own history. You will likely see the Place de la Concorde with its Egyptian obelisk, fountains, statues and columns, the Madeleine church looking like a Greek temple, then the Opéra Garnier gorgeous architecture from the 19th century, the rue de la Paix with its luxurious jewelry, Place Vendôme with its column commissioned by Napoléon.

Beaune is a charming historic town in the heart of France's Burgundy wine region, renowned for its picturesque streets, beautiful architecture, and exceptional wines. The town is home to the famous Hôtel-Dieu, a colorful 15th-century former hospital with distinctive glazed-tile roofs that has become one of Burgundy's most recognizable landmarks. Surrounded by vineyards producing celebrated Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, Beaune offers visitors opportunities for wine tasting, exploring local markets, enjoying traditional Burgundian cuisine, and discovering its rich cultural heritage. With its relaxed atmosphere and elegant old-world character, Beaune is an ideal destination for travelers interested in French history, food, and wine.

Once back on the bus enjoy the approx. 2 hour ride to the Lyon cruise port.

Perhaps take a walk along the Promenade des Anglais! Nice's Promenade des Anglais is lined with cafes situated directly on the beach, and it is a bustling area active with cyclists, runners, walkers, and roller bladers. It has existed for decades, dating back to the 1800s when aristocrats from throughout Europe flocked to the inviting Cote d'Azur city.

Today, it is a thriving concourse along the Riviera city, home to many landmark hotels, dozens of cafes, and miles of beach. It stretches from the airport on the western side to Old Nice (and the quai des Etats-Unis) to the east.

Nice's colorful Vieille Ville, or Old Town, is a delightful maze of narrow streets full of lively restaurants, galleries, and shops. There are cafés dotted all around the Old Town's many squares, so take the opportunity to sit down, coffee in hand and people-watch the day away. Stroll along the near-mile Promenade du Paillon, the city's public park and botanical garden that links the Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art.
